EPA will provide a brief presentation on progress toward a final remedy proposal and recently completed on-site actions. EPA will provide the presentation three times throughout the event at 5 p.m., 6 p.m., and 7 p.m. The remainder of the time EPA staff will be available to meet individually with members of the community to discuss site progress and answer questions. EPA has also invited the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry, the U.S. Geological Survey, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, St. Louis County Health Department, and Missouri American Water. During the open house, EPA and the attending agencies will staff tables or stations at which the public can meet with the various experts.
